



## Cooley's Anemia Foundation

### How does your donation to the Cooley's Anemia Foundation help children with thalassemia (aka Cooley's anemia)?

#### **\$500**

Pays for transportation costs for a child to obtain vital annual comprehensive care at one of the select Thalassemia Treatment Centers of Excellence. These visits are important in monitoring the patient's care and determining what adjustments must be made to improve patient outcomes.

#### **\$1000**

Provides support to a family that has adopted a child with thalassemia. The decision to welcome a child with thalassemia into a family comes with significant costs, and the Cooley's Anemia Foundation helps families with a newly-adopted thalassemic child get started with this funding.

#### **\$2500**

Enables a family of three to attend and learn from our annual Patient-Family Conference. Because thalassemia is a rare disease, many Cooley's anemia children grow up feeling isolated and alone. Our annual Conference introduces these children to others just like them who become lifelong friends and peers. And parents and siblings also benefit from meeting others who understand exactly what they are going through.

#### **\$5000**

Funds the Cooley's Anemia Foundation's Patient Support Program, which provides children with thalassemia and their families with informational material to better manage their disease; virtual patient support meetings so that patients can discuss challenges they are facing and devise strategies to meet them; and social media outreach to connect the community across the nation.
