

Today, the Knights and Dames of the Dynastic Orders of the Royal House of Savoy can be found around the globe, especially throughout Italy, the rest of Europe, North and South America, Australia and Japan. Worldwide administration of the Savoy Orders is directed by the Chancellery of the Orders in Geneva, Switzerland. Members of the Savoy Orders are organized into National and Regional Delegations. The Italian Delegations presently include: Abruzzo, Basilicata, Calabria, Molise, Apulia, Campania, Friuli Venezia-Giulia, Lazio, Liguria, Lombardy, Marche, Piedmont, Sicily, Tuscany, Umbria, Valle D'Aosta. In Europe, the Delegations include: Corsica, France, Savoy, Scandinavia and Switzerland.

In addition to the American Delegation (which includes the United States), the worldwide Delegations presently include: Brazil, Canada and Japan.

The international charitable activities of the Orders are directed by the *Association Internationale des Chevaliers des Ordres Dynastique de la Maison Royale de Savoie* (International Association of Knights of the Dynastic Orders of the Royal House of Savoy) and the *Oeuvres Hospitalierès de l'Ordre des Saints Maurice et Lazare* (Hospitalier Works of the Order of Saints Maurice and Lazarus).






The Foundation was formed primarily to provide support - for hospitals and relief agencies and assistance for the poor, sick, and elderly. These charitable and humanitarian purposes are in keeping with the centuries old hospitaller traditions of the Order of Saints Maurice and Lazarus. Contributions to the Foundation and its charitable projects are tax deductible to the extent permitted by law.

In 2005, the Foundation became a Non-Governmental Organization(NGO) in Roster Consultative Status with the Economic and Social Council of the United Nations. This important role enables the Foundation to participate in the medical, poverty and educational work of the United Nations. It also provides an excellent opportunity to form strategic alliances with the international philanthropic community with which the Savoy Orders are already active.

In 2019, the Foundation adopted a focused new mission statement: Chivalry for Children's Causes. Major donations this year include: Caterina' Club on the West Coast which feeds 5,000 children each night in Los Angeles and Orange Counties, to Mercy Ships, a Texas based charity that funds surgeries for children in Africa, and to the NY Foundling that provides summer camp experiences for foster care children in the tri-state area.

While deeply rooted in the past, the Savoy Orders are actively engaged in the challenges of modern society. The Savoy Foundation undertakes humanitarian, hospitaller and charitable projects and initiatives across North America and abroad, particularly in healthcare, disaster relief and educational programs. Members of the Royal Family actively support, attend and lend their names through formal patronage of these worthy events and causes.

Proceeds from the Foundation's events are donated to hospitals, orphanages and other humanitarian causes. These events provide valuable support enabling the Savoy Foundation to carry out its charitable work to aid children's causes, hospice care for the poor, sick and infirm, and to produce the annual Savoy History Lecture Series focusing on the history of Italy and the Savoy dynasty.





The Savoy Foundation sponsors the Savoy History Series, an annual presentation given by distinguished scholars and masters in their respective fields and sometimes by members of the Italian Royal Family on a topic related to the House of Savoy, and the history of Italy, Italian literature, history, art, music, science and impact on other countries. A wide array of extraordinary lectures and dynamic conversations featuring topics in Italian history and highlights from current exhibitions, film discussion and musical performances related to Italy and the Savoy dynasty provide interesting insights from a unique perspective. Savoy History Series is a program of the Savoy Foundation.

AMERICAN DELEGATION OF SAVOY ORDERS

The American Delegation of Savoy Orders, located in New York City, administers the Savoy Orders in the United States. It is led by a Delegate appointed by the Grand Master, H.R.H. Prince Victor Emmanuel, Prince of Naples and Duke of Savoy. The American Delegate, candidates, members and friends of the American Delegation of Savoy Orders attend the annual Capitolo Generale (Chapter General) of the Savoy Orders, usually held each year in Geneva, Switzerland or in Rome, Italy.

A formal installation ceremony is presided over by H.R.H. Prince Victor Emmanuel of Savoy, the Grand Master. On this occasion, diplomas and insignia are presented to the new members and newly promoted members of the Savoy Orders. The same evening, a formal benefit gala dinner raises funds for the international charitable works of the Savoy Orders. The following day there is a solemn Mass and procession of Knights and Dames in their church robes.

The weekend of events usually concludes with a guided tour of Savoy-related historic sites for the members and guests of the American Delegation. By special arrangement, members and promotions, who with good cause are unable to attend the installation ceremonies in Switzerland, may be presented their honors in the United States. Each year the Savoy Orders sponsor a number of social activities, anniversary observances and religious services. Activities of the American Delegation include financial support of the fundraising charitable, humanitarian, cultural and educational events of the American Foundation of Savoy Orders, Incorporated. The Delegation also arranges for the Knights and Dames of the Savoy Orders to attend the celebration of Masses during the year: a commemorative Mass and dinner for St. Lazarus Day in February or March and a Mass in December in conjunction with the Savoy Foundation's annual winter reception and dinner dance, Ballo di Savoia.

The American Delegate appoints members of the National Council of the American Delegation of Savoy Orders, which meets semi-annually to assist him with administration of the Savoy Orders in North America. The meeting includes reports from the Vice Delegates, special Project Coordinators and Regional Representatives about the organization and activities of the Savoy Orders in their respective geographical areas, as well as planning for support of the Delegation's and the Savoy Foundation's events and programs.



In 2019 the Savoy Foundation USA launched a new philanthropic initiative - Chivalry for Children's Causes. With funds raised at the 2019 Notte di Savoia Los Angeles Gala Dinner, a major grant was presented to Caterina's Club. The Southern California based charity provides meals, housing, and job training for disadvantaged children and families. Through a generous donation by the Mark Pigott Family, the Savoy Foundation in December 2010 established the Savoy Orders Pigott Scholarship Fund, supplemented by the Family's additional generous contributions in November 2011 and 2012, to provide scholarships to college students for studies in the Humanities and International Affairs.
